Correspondence Out:	<p>It was agreed that the following letters will be drafted and sent out on behalf of ABAGRA:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Letter to VicRoads requesting signage on Railway Avenue for entry to Freeway saying 'Melbourne' and to have sign saying 'Geelong' moved further along Railway Avenue. • Letter to VicRoads requesting that a sign saying 'Laverton' (pointing left) and 'Altona Meadows' (pointing right) be erected at 'T' intersection at Newlands Street and Merton Street, and the existing signage saying 'Laverton' and 'Altona' be removed. • Letter to be sent to our Local Member supporting proposed duplication of Queen Street. • Letter to Hobson's Bay City Council suggesting information board/signage promoting local attractions/places of interest to be erected at entrance of HD Graham Reserve (Basketball stadium entrance), Altona Meadows Library and Bruce Comben Reserve along Queen Street. • Letter to Local Ward Councillors requesting street tree planting as an Avenue of trees to improve entrance to Altona Meadows on Newlands Street. (Since our meeting, this has been completed by council). • Letter to Hobson's Bay City Council recommending that rubbish bins be placed at <u>all</u> bus stops and reserves along Victoria Street. • Service Management request be re-initiated to have line-marking along Queen, Victoria and Merton Streets completed. • Send copy of HBCC response to ABAGRA letter regarding various issues to local Resident
General Business:	<p>Secretary to follow up on Budget submission. Secretary to scan letter from HBCC dated August 7th and forward to President. It was agreed that ABAGRA would in future publish 4 newsletters per year, have 4 executive meetings per year and 1 public meeting/AGM per year.
