Smoke-free Policy

Rationale

The Bendigo Yacht Club recognises that passive smoking is hazardous to health and that non-smokers should be protected from tobacco smoke.

Accordingly, the following policy has been approved by the Bendigo Yacht Club General Committee to be effective from 1 March 2002.

Policy on Smoking

The clubhouse and all other buildings have been designated Smoke-free, including:

- administration and office areas,
- change rooms and toilets,
- the entrance lobby,
- the main common room,
- all boat sheds,
- other utility sheds

This applies at all times including all social functions and meetings.

The Smoke-free policy will apply to junior events and competitions including coaches, trainers, volunteers and officials.

Smoking is also banned in all Rescue and Race control craft.

Cigarettes are not to be sold including from vending machines.

Non-compliance

Non-compliance with this policy will result in action being taken by the committee. Anyone wishing to discuss any aspect of this policy is invited to contact a member of the General Committee.

Policy Review

The policy on smoking will be reviewed six (6) months after its introduction (1/10/2002) and then on an annual basis to ensure that the policy remains current and practical.
