FEES

Once again term fees will be sent out or handed to each swimmer or swimmer's family when term 2 commences and were required to be paid by week 2 of the term.

At this stage, there are still families who have yet to pay the fees whilst their children have continued to train with the club. As well as the term fees we also sent out the "Swimming Victoria" registration forms and fees that were also required to be brought back and paid for by the 2nd week of the term.

Please be advised that if you have any outstanding fees and you have not made an arrangement with Joe Xerri that these fees are required to be paid by this Sunday 14th June.

If your child has not returned their "Swimming Victoria" registration forms with the fee, please be advised that due to your child not having the required insurance liability that comes with the Swim Vic registration, they will not be able to train with the team and will be asked to leave the pool as the club does not accept liability if an injury or accident occurs.

Sunday morning fees have increased for those swimmers who do not pay term fees from \$5 to \$10 as of Sunday 14/02/2009.

Details of fees:

Term Fees will be:

- \$60 for Juniors for entire term
- \$65 for Seniors for entire term.

We have special Family term fees as well for those who have more than 1 child in the club.

- Family of 2 swimmers will cost \$110 per term and
- Family of 3 swimmers will cost \$150 per term.

These fees all go towards club expenses such as wages for Coaches, trophies for presentation night, Xmas party & gifts for swimmers, bus hire for MSAC, team entry fees for MSAC etc.
