GROENENDAEL - DOGS

CLASS 01 – BABY PUPPY DOG: (1 Entry)

1st NO. 1 – MIRRIBANDI MAKEMINE BLAK (Lumineux Kennels)
4½ months. Complete bite but slightly undershot, good muzzle, could have a bit more stop. Flat skull. Good pigmentation. Very nice dark eyes. Small ears and high set. Good neck, good back, a sloping croup. Good chest for the age. A bit straight in shoulder and well angulated in rear. Good movement in rear but still very loose in front. Good tail.
PROMISING.

CLASS 04 – JUNIOR DOG: (1 Entry)

1st NO. 2 – REX BERGERAC DE HU (IMP BLG) (L. Trotter)
13 months. Complete scissor bite. Good muzzle. Could have more stop. Skull a bit receding. Dark eyes. Well placed ears. Nice neck. Good back, a sloping croup. Chest should become deeper. Slightly turned out elbows. Well angulated in front and the rear. Good temperament. In movement narrow in rear, loose in the elbows and gay tail.
EXCELLENT

CLASS 05 – INTERMEDIATE DOG: (3 Entries – 1 Absent)

1st NO. 4 – MIRRIBANDI GRYPHONDREAM (Lumineux Kennels)
20 months. Complete scissor bite. Well pigmented. Good muzzle. Should have more stop. Flat skull. Dark eyes. Small ears which could be higher placed on the head. Good neck. A good short back. Sloping croup. Good chest. Well angulated in front and rear. Loosing coat. In the movement narrow in rear and in front and could cover more ground. Good tail.
EXCELLENT

2nd NO. 3 – TARRARAY FAOLAN (D. & R. Cecil)
22 months. Complete scissor bite. Slight loss of pigmentation. Short head with enough stop but skull a bit round. Eyes could be a bit darker. Mid long ears well placed but large at the base. Good neck. Back should be shorter. Sloping croup. Chest well developed. Well angulated in front and rear. Slightly turned out elbows. Missing undercoat. Movement narrow in the rear and loose in front. Covering enough ground. Good tail and good temperament. **VERY GOOD**

CLASS 10 – AUSTRALIAN BRED DOG: (5 Entries – 1 Absent)

1st NO. 9 – BELJEKALI JEAN AUBERT (J. & Mrs. S. Waring)

2½ years. Complete scissor bite. Well pigmented. Good muzzle. The skull could be more flat. Eyes should be darker. Well placed ears. Good neck. Good short back. Good croup. Tail could be a bit longer. Chest well developed. Could be more angulated in front. Well angulated in rear. Good coat and undercoat. Good movement in rear; a little loose in front. Covering enough ground. **EXCELLENT**

2nd NO. 6 – CH TANKARLA MARNEHANTARDI HIT (S & Mrs K Houston)

4 years. Complete pincer bite with one double P1. Loss of pigmentation. Good muzzle and stop. Skull a bit receding. Eyes a bit rounded and could be a bit darker. Ears could be higher set on the head and a bit large at the base. Good back but a bit long for a male. Croup slightly sloping. Chest well developed. Weak pasterns, turned out front feet. Well angulated in front and rear. Very narrow movement in rear and loose in front. Covering enough ground and limping in left front leg. Good tail. **EXCELLENT MINUS.**

3rd NO. 7 – LUMINEUX A NIGHT OWL (Lumineux Kennels)

2½ years. Complete scissor bite. Roman nose. Enough stop. A good skull. Eyes could be darker. Small ears, well set. Could hve more neck. Good back but should be shorter and a good croup. Chest could be broader in front. Well angulated in front and rear. Turned out front feet. Missing undercoat. In the movement very narrow in the front and loose in the rear. Small male that should be more masculine. Movement not parallel. **VERY GOOD**

NO. 8 – CH MIRRIBANDI UNCOVERED (Lumineux Kennels)

4 years. Complete pincer bite. Loss of pigmentation. Good muzzle, should have more stop. Good skull. Eyes could be darker. Ears low set and large at the base. Could have more neck. Straight back, but too long. Good croup. Tail a bit short. Just not enough developed. Could have more shoulder angulation. Well angulated in rear. Loosing coat. Coat needs more care. Coat very dry. Movement a bit narrow in rear, good in front. Covering enough ground. **VERY GOOD**

CLASS 11 – OPEN DOG: (5 Entries – 2 Absent)

1st NO. 11 – CH BRIGAND DE LA QUIEVRE (IMP BLG) (G. Carroll)

3½ years. Complete pincer bite. Well pigmented. Well chiselled head with flat skull but could have more stop. Dark eyes, small ears, very well set. Nice neck. Good straight back. Could be a bit shorter. Good croup. Chest well developed. Well angulated in front and in rear. Nice cat feet. Good coat and undercoat. Good temperament. Very good movement and covering enough ground **EXCELLENT**

**2nd NO. 14 – GR CH & HUNG CH SR ICH HCH HSCH GR HCH HJCH
OCH OJCH SKCH – BERGERAC FAUST – IP01
AGILITY 3 (IMP HGY)** (Lynda Trotter/M. Lund)

4 years. Complete scissor bite. Well pigmented. Good muzzle. Missing stop. Good skull. Eyes could be darker. Small ears which could be higher set on the head. Good neck. Good short back. Sloping croup. Chest could be broader. Well angulated in front and rear. Pasterns a bit weak and slightly turned out front feet. Good coat and undercoat. In the movement narrow in rear, loose in front. Good tail. **EXCELLENT**

3rd NO. 13 – CH A-TE-ELL'S MONSIEUR QUINCY (IMP SWD)
(A. Macandie & J. Carroll)

4 years. Complete bite but incisors are separated with no contact. Roman nose. Good stop. Skull receding. Dark eyes, mid long ears which could be higher set on head, large at base. Good back, sloping croup. Chest well developed. Well angulated in front and the rear. Good coat and undercoat. Narrow movement in rear and in front. Gay tail. During movement back is a little weak. Should remain straighter. **VERY GOOD**

CLASS 12 VETERAN DOG: (2 Entries)

1st NO. 16 – CH LANAKEN MOON SHADOW (J. Carroll)

9½ years. Complete bite half scissor, half pincer. Loss of pigmentation. Strong head. Missing stop. Dark eyes, ears could be higher set and are large at the base. Good neck. Straight back but should be shorter. Croup sloping. Chest well developed. Could be more angulated in shoulder, well angulated in rear. Turned out front feet. Good coat and undercoat. Narrow in rear movement, a bit loose in front, not covering enough ground **EXCELLENT**

2nd NO. 17 – LA BARRIQUE LA HIGHLANDER (A.R. & G.A. Harley)

7½ years. Complete scissor bite, loss of pigmentation. Short head with Roman nose and receding skull. Missing parallel planes. Dark eyes, a bit round. Small ears, very well set. Could have more neck. Good back, sloping croup. Narrow chest. Well angulated in front and rear. Good coat and undercoat. Narrow in rear movement and very loose in front with weak pasterns. Good tail. **VERY GOOD**

GROENENDAEL BITCHES

CLASS 04A – JUNIOR BITCH: (2 Entries)

1st NO. 18 – LUMINEUX TANI (Paul Baker)

12 months. Complete scissor bite. Nice feminine head. Could have a bit more stop. Dark eyes. Very well set ears, a bit large at the base. Could have a bit more neck. Good back, croup a bit sloping. Chest well developed for the age. Well angulated in front and the rear. Good coat texture. Movement narrow in rear and still loose in front. Good tail. Nice temperament. **EXCELLENT**

2nd NO. 19 – LUMINEUX TIA (Lumineux Kennels)

12 months. Complete pincer bite. Slightly Roman nose. Flat skull. Dark eyes. Well placed ears, a bit large at the base. Good neck, straight back which could be shorter. Good croup. Chest enough developed for the age. Well angulated in front and rear. Nice cat feet, missing undercoat. Narrow in rear movement, bit loose in front and good tail. **EXCELLENT**

CLASS 05A – INTERMEDIATE BITCH: (1 Entry)

1st NO. 20 – CH LUMINEUX AFTER DARK (Lumineux Kennels)

Nearly 3 years. Complete scissor bite. Good muzzle and flat skull. Could have more stop. Eyes could be a bit darker. Small well set ears. Could have more neck. Back a bit weak and croup a bit sloping. Chest well developed. Well angulated in front, could be more angulated in rear. Hindquarter a bit too much red in the coat, should be more black in the hindquarters. Narrow in rear movement, loose in front. Good tail, back not straight. **VERY GOOD**

CLASS 10A – AUSTRALIAN BRED BITCH: (4 Entries – 1 Absent)

1st NO. 23 – BELJEKALI ELEGANT BELLE (Mrs. K. & S. Houston)

6 years. Complete scissor bite. Small bitch. Muzzle a bit snipey, missing stop, flat skull. Dark eyes, well placed ears a bit large at the base. Good neck. Good short back, croup a bit sloping. Chest could be broader. Could have more shoulder angulation. Slightly turned out front feet. Well angulated in rear. Good coat texture but missing undercoat. In movement narrow in rear, a bit loose in front and a good tail. **EXCELLENT**

2nd NO. 21 – CH GRANDBELGE CLEOPATRA (AI) HIT (G. Carroll)

5 years. Complete pincer bite. Loss of pigmentation. Good muzzle and stop. Flat skull. Dark eyes but a bit round. Well placed ears, a bit large at the base. Very nice long neck. Good back. Croup a bit sloping. Chest well developed. Enough angulated in front, well angulated in rear. Good coat texture. Movement a bit narrow in rear and front. Good tail, enough ground covering. **EXCELLENT**

3rd NO. 24 – LUMINEUX EBONY MIST (Lumineux Kennels)

4 years. Complete scissor bite. Good muzzle, should have more stop. Flat skull. Eyes could be darker and are a bit round. Well set ears, large at the base. Good neck, short back, sloping croup. Chest well developed. Turned out elbows. Well angulated in front and rear. Nice cat feet. Too much red in coat in the chest. Needs ring training. Temperament should be more confident. In the movement good in the rear but loose in the elbows. Good tail. **VERY GOOD**

CLASS 11A – OPEN BITCH: (3 Entries – 1 Absent)

1st NO. 25 - NINJA VAN'T BELGISCH SCHOON (IMP NDL) (G. Carroll)

6 years. Complete scissor bite, slight loss of pigmentation. Well chiselled head with good muzzle and flat skull. Dark eyes, ears very well set, nice neck, straight back, croup a bit sloping. Chest well developed. Could be more angulated in front, well angulated in rear. Nice cat feet. Good coat texture. In the movement narrow in rear and in front. Covering enough ground. Good tail **EXCELLENT**

2nd NO. 27 – CH MIRRIBANDI MORGANNAH (Lumineux Kennels)

6 years. Complete scissor bite, slight loss of pigmentation. Muzzle a bit snipey, flat skull, dark eyes, a bit round. Small well placed ears. Could have more neck. Short straight back, croup a bit sloping. Chest should be broader. Enough angulated in front, well angulated in rear. Good coat texture, but missing undercoat. In the movement very narrow in rear, a bit loose in front. Good tail. **EXCELLENT**

CLASS 12A – VETERAN BITCH: (3 Entries)

1st NO. 28. CH CHIVA V.'T BELGISCH SCHOON (IMP NDL) (G. Carroll)
9 years. Scissor bite, missing one incisor upper jaw (Veterinary Certificate). Muzzle a bit snikey, flat skull. Dark eyes. Mid long ears, well set. Nice neck. Straight back, good croup. Chest enough developed. Could have more shoulder angulation, well angulated in rear. Out of coat, missing undercoat and could have more bone. In the movement very narrow in rear, a bit loose in the elbows. A good tail. **EXCELLENT**

2nd NO. 30 – CH LUMINEUX HELLS BELLS (Lumineux Kennels)
9 years. Complete scissor bite. Loss of pigmentation. Short head which could have more stop. Skull a bit round. Dark eyes. Small ears which could be higher placed on the head. Good neck. Good short back, good croup. Chest well developed. Turned out elbows. Well angulated in front and the rear. Good coat texture, but missing undercoat. In the movement good in rear but loose in elbows. Could cover more ground. Good tail. **EXCELLENT**

3rd NO. 29 – CH LANAKEN NOTICE ME (N.A. Hoffman & R. Keech)
8½ years. Complete scissor bite, a slightly Roman nose. Should have more stop. Flat skull. Dark eyes. Well set ears but large at the base. Good neck. Good back which could be a bit shorter. Croup a bit sloping. Chest well developed. Well angulated in front and in rear. Good coat. In the movement a bit narrow in rear and in front, covering enough ground. Good tail and during movement back dips a little - a little weak. **EXCELLENT**

13 months. Complete scissor bite. Nice head. Good muzzle and flat skull. Dark eyes but a bit round. Mid long ears which could be higher set on the head. Nice neck. Good back and croup. Chest should become deeper. Enough angulated in front, well angulated in rear. Good coat texture and good furnishings. In the movement narrow in rear and loose in front. **EXCELENT**

CLASS 05 – INTERMEDIATE DOG: (1 Entry)

NO. 32 – CH AUSTRALAKEN AGIER (L. Longmuir)
Nearly 3 years. Complete bite. Undershot. Strong head with short muzzle and broad skull. Dark eyes. Ears should be higher placed on the head. Good neck. Weak back and should be shorter. Good croup. Tail should be longer. Chest well developed. Well angulated in front and the rear. Pasterns a bit weak. Good coat texture and furnishing. In the movement good in rear, narrow in front, weak back. **GOOD (because of the bite – Non Awarded)**

CLASS 10 – AUSTRALIAN BRED DOG: (1 Entry)

1st NO. 33 – CH LANAKEN RUFF N READY (IID) HIT (Miss K. Edwards)

4 years. Complete scissor bite. Good strong muzzle. Good stop. Skull a bit receding. Dark eyes, a bit round. Well placed ears. Nice neck. Good back and croup. Low set tail. Chest well developed. A bit straight in shoulder. Well angulated in rear. Very good coat texture and furnishing. Nice colour. Movement covering enough ground but a bit narrow in front and the rear. **EXCELLENT**

Chest well developed. Well angulated in front and rear. Good coat colour, texture and furnishing. In the movement cow-hocked in rear. Loose in front. Good tail. **EXCELLENT**

4 years. Complete scissor bite. Slightly Roman nose. Good stop and skull. Dark eyes. Well placed ears. Good neck. Back could be straighter and shorter. Sloping croup and tail. Could be a bit longer. Chest well developed. Should be more angulated in front. Well angulated in rear. Good coat texture. Nice colour and good mask. In the movement good in the rear, a bit loose in front and good tail. **EXCELLENT**

16 months. Complete scissor bite. Short head, but with good muzzle and skull. Eyes could be a bit darker. Ears very well placed. Very well pigmented. Good neck. Good back, croup a bit sloping and tail low set. Good chest. A bit straight in shoulder, well angulated in the rear. The bone could be stronger. Good colour and good mask. In the movement narrow in rear and in front and could cover more ground. **EXCELLENT**

2nd NO. 38 – BELGENBEAU BE ZED ARINYA (Ms. S. Trembath)
14 months. Complete scissor bite. Good muzzle and skull but could have more stop. Eyes could be darker. Mid long ears, well set. Nice neck. Straight back, but too long. Sloping croup. Chest should be deeper and broader. Straight in the shoulder. Enough angulated in the rear. Turned out front feet. Good mask and colour. In the movement narrow in the rear, loose in front. Back a bit weak during the movement. **VERY GOOD**

CLASS 05A – INTERMEDIATE BITCH: (1 Entry)

1st NO. 39 – CH BELGENBEAU SASSY FANTOM (Ms. J. Cook)
22 months. Complete scissor bite. Very well pigmented. Nice feminine head with good stop. Dark eyes. Ears very well set. Nice neck. Good short back. Good croup. Chest could be a bit deeper. A bit straight in shoulder, well angulated in the rear. Good coat and texture, colour and mask. Tail could be a bit longer. In the movement very good movement covering a lot of ground. Good tail. **EXCELLENT**

Chest well developed. Bit straight in shoulder, turned out front feet and well angulated in the rear. Good coat and undercoat. Good mask and nice colour. Good movement in the rear, a bit loose in front. Good tail. **EXCELLENT**

CLASS 10 – AUSTRALIAN BRED DOG: (2 Entries)

NO. 41 – **GR CH AISANCE EAGLES FLIGHT (AI) HIT** (K. Edwards)
7 years. Complete bite but slightly undershot. Good muzzle, enough stop. Receding skull. Eyes could be darker. Ears could be higher placed on head. Could have more neck. Good back and croup, chest well developed. Enough angulated in front. Well angulated in rear. Good mask, nice warm colour. Good movement covering enough ground but a bit loose in front. Good tail. **GOOD (because of bite – non awarded)**

NO. 42 – **CH ASHENDAEL TALK TO ME** (Mrs. N.A. Hoffman)
3 years. Complete scissor bite. Nice head, but could have more stop. Good muzzle and flat skull. Eyes should be darker. Very well placed ears. Nice neck. Straight back, but should be shorter. Sloping croup. Chest well developed. Should be more angulated in front. Well angulated in the rear. Good coat texture, lacks full mask. Colour pale and lacks warmth and charbonnage. Movement – Cow-hocked in rear. Good in front, covering enough ground and good tail. **GOOD (non awarded)**

CLASS 11 – OPEN CLASS DOG: (3 Entries – 1 Absent)

1st NO. 44 - **CH GRIMMENDANS YUCAN (IMP BLG)** (D.R. & J.D. Voll)
6 years. Complete scissor bite. Well pigmented. Nice masculine head, well chiselled. Could have a bit more stop. Very nice dark eyes. Small ears. Well set. Could have a bit more neck. Straight short back and good croup. Chest well developed. Well angulated in front and the rear. Good coat and undercoat. Good mask and very nice warm colour. Very good movement and good tail. **EXCELLENT**

2nd NO. 45 – **AM, CAN UKC CH ASPEN DE PEINDRE AU VIF (IMP USA)**
(Mrs. L. Trotter)
7 years. Complete scissor bite. Well pigmented. Muzzle a bit snipey. Could have more stop. Flat skull. Dark eyes, a bit round. Well placed ears, a bit large at the base. Good neck, good short back. Croup a bit sloping. Chest well developed. A bit straight in shoulder. Turned out front feet. Well angulated in the rear. Good mask. Nice colour. Missing undercoat at the moment. Narrow in rear movement and in front. Covering enough ground and good tail. **EXCELLENT**

CLASS 12 – VETERAN DOG: (1 Entry)

1st NO. 46 – CH UZZI VAN DE HOGE LAER (IMP BLG) (Lumineux Kennels)
Nearly 9 years. Complete scissor. Masculine head. Good muzzle, flat skull. Dark eyes. Small ears which could be higher placed on the head. Could have more neck. Straight back which should be shorter. Croup a bit sloping. Chest well developed. Well angulated in front and rear. Weak pasterns. Good mask. Good colour but charbonnage too black on brisket area. Movement sufficient for the age and good tail. **EXCELLENT**

CLASS 02A – MINOR PUPPY BITCH: (1 Entry)

1st NO. 47 – ASHENDAEL STRUT MY STUFF (Mrs. N. & Miss A. Hoffman)
7 months. Complete scissor bite. Very well pigmented. Very nice feminine head with good parallelism. Dark eyes. Ears very well set, but large at the base. Very nice neck. Good back, croup a bit sloping. Chest well developed for the age. Should be more angulated in front, well angulated in rear. Nice cat feet. Good mask. Colour should be warmer. Movement still narrow in rear, a bit loose in front. Good tail. **VERY PROMISING**

CLASS 03A – PUPPY BITCH: (1 Entry)

1st NO. 48 – DEVIEBELLE MY SHEBOSS (D.R. & J.D. Voll)
12 months. Complete scissor bite. Muzzle a bit snikey. Flat skull. Could have more stop. Dark eyes. Well placed ears, a bit large at the base. Very nice neck. Straight back and good croup. Chest well developed for the age. Enough shoulder angulation and well angulated in the rear. Good mask and colour. Narrow in rear movement and a bit loose in front. Cover enough ground and good tail. **VERY PROMISING**

CLASS 04A – JUNIOR BITCH: (1 Entry)

1st NO. 49 – TANKARLA CHEYENNE (Mrs. K. & S. Houston)
10 months. Scissor bite. One P2 missing in the left underjaw. Well pigmented. Nice feminine head with good muzzle and flat skull. Dark eyes. Well placed ears. Good neck, good short back and good croup. Chest should become deeper. Well angulated in front and rear. Good mask and colour. In the movement narrow in the rear and front. Good tail. **VERY GOOD.**

CLASS 10A – AUSTRALIAN BRED BITCH: (4 Entries)

1st NO. 51 – CH ERLANDER BELLA BRIANNA (AI) CD ET (R. & Mrs. B Dunlop)
6 years. Complete scissor bite. Nice head with good parallelism. Good muzzle and flat skull, but could have a bit more stop. Nice dark eyes. Well placed ears. Very nice neck. Good back, sloping croup. Chest well developed. Slightly turned out elbows. Well angulated in front and rear. Good mask and colour. In the movement slightly cow-hocked in rear and loose in the elbows. Covering enough ground. Good tail. **EXCELLENT**

2nd NO. 53 – CH DEVIEBELLE ZOMAX ZISTA (C.J. & S.G. Greer)
6 years. Complete scissor bite. Good muzzle. Skull a bit receding, eyes could be a bit darker and ears could be higher placed on the head. Nice neck. Straight short back, sloping croup. Chest well developed. Very well angulated in front and rear. Good mask. Too much charbonnage on the body., In the movement good in front, a bit narrow in the rear. Covering enough ground and good tail. **EXCELLENT**

3rd NO. 52 – CH ERLANDER UZETTE AMETHYST (Ms. B.J. Durran)
