

RVBA GROUP 12 MAROONDAH NIGHT PENNANT 2009/2010

RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. **RVBA Regulations for Attire** shall apply i.e. whites/creams or Club colours shall be worn.
2. **Fee** of \$5.00 (including GST) per player shall be paid to the Club at which the match is played.
3. **Night Pennant Result Sheet** shall be completed and signed by both Managers and shall be mailed, faxed or emailed to the **Recorder** the following day at the latest.
Note: A fine of \$10.00 will be imposed on any Club whose Result Sheet has not been received by Friday in the week of the match.
Pennant Ladders will be available on the Heatherdale BC website www.hrbc.org.au
4. Matches shall **commence at 7.30 p.m.** after one end **roll-up** - two ends for semi-finals and final.
Note: No supper is required to be arranged or served.
5. In **Sectional Play, 21 ends** shall be played if completed by **10.30 p.m.** If not completed by this time, games shall terminate with the completion of the end in play at 10.30 p.m. and no new end shall be started or replayed after this time. **Semi-finals and Final matches** shall be 21 ends but with no time limit.
6. As in RVBA Pennant, **18 Points** shall be allocated to each match: **10 Points** to the **winning side** and **2 Points** to each **winning team**. In the event of a tie, **5 Points** shall be awarded to **each tied side** and **1 Point** to **each tied team**.
A side having a **Bye** shall receive **18 Points**.
A side receiving a **Walkover** shall receive **18 Points plus 15 Shots up**. A side giving a **Walkover** shall forfeit **15 Shots**.
7. In the event of **cancelled** or **incompleted matches** (for **inclement weather** or other reason), each side shall be awarded **9 Points**. However, if **48 or more ends** have been played, then the match shall be deemed to have been completed; the result at the time of abandonment shall stand and the **18 points** allocated in the usual way. In the event of all matches in a Section being cancelled (for inclement weather or other reason), no points shall be awarded. This includes any side having a Bye.
In the case of semi-finals or final, the match shall be completed or replayed the following week at the same venue or as otherwise agreed.
Clubs shall notify opponents as soon as possible if their green(s) is closed.
Note: The decision to cancel games shall be by the home side and with no direction from the Committee.
8. The **Three Section Winners** and best **Second Side** shall contest the **Semi-finals**.
All players competing in the **Semi-finals and Final** matches shall have played in at least 3 Sectional matches in the Section for which the Side is selected.
9. All bowlers shall be **RVBA Affiliates** or, in the case of **Dual Membership**, shall be paid up **Bowling Members** of the Club Side for which they are selected, except that **two non-affiliated ladies** may be selected per Side but only **one** may be included per team.
10. All other Laws, Rules and Conditions shall be as in the **Laws of the Sport of Bowls and RVBA Rules for Competition**.
11. Any changes to **Side Managers** in the season shall be notified to the Recorder or Secretary immediately.
12. **The Perpetual Shield** shall be presented to the winning side and **Trophies** awarded to the winning side and to the runners-up.
