The Summit Park Versatile Arabian Award will be awarded to the horse which shows the most versatility on the day.

Eligibility:

To be eligible, the horse must compete in all of the following categories:

- One Halter class (Ring 1 or Ring 2)
  - One Ridden breed class (Ring or Ring 2)
  - Two Activity classes (Ring 4) see note 2
  - One Open Saddle class (Section A only) See Note 3
- ONE HORSE/ONE RIDER RULE APPLIES*

**Please Note: A maximum of thirteen (13) events is allowed to be nominated but only the best ten (10) will be used for calculation of the placings of the award. These events must be nominated on the performance card.**

Note 1 (a) No points will be awarded towards the Versatile Award from classes 401-406 inclusive nor from the Junior Judging.

(b) Classes denoted as 'Special' are not qualifiers for eligibility but can be used once the eligibility rules are met.

Note 2 Where a Novice and Open class are provided, only one can be used to meet eligibility rules.

Note 3 Only one event from classes 80-85 and classes 126 & 127 can be nominated.

SCORING:

Once the compulsory ELIGIBILITY pre-requisites are met, placing from all other events, including Specials, will be used to score each exhibit.

Scoring will be dependent on no. of entries in each class and will be as follows:

Supreme Champion – 3 points, Champion – 2 points, Reserve – 1 point.

NOTE: Points are not scored for Champion Activity Horses as this is awarded on aggregate of scores.

ENTRY FEE for this award is free and is to be nominated on entry forms with original entries or prior to 10am on the day. Performance cards will be available from the Secretary.

Exhibitors are advised to carry these cards at all times as they must be signed before leaving each class. Cards to be handed to the Secretary at the completion of the day.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. All horses must be registered with the AHSA and be carrying legible brands. Proof of registration must be produced at the Secretary's office prior to judging and registration papers must accompany all entry forms.
2. All ridden exhibits must be three years and over
3. Hard hats (ASA 3838) and boots with heels must be worn for all ridden events except where specific attire is required.
4. All entries must be made on the provided entry form and must be accompanied by the entry fees. Late entries will be accepted on the day at a surcharge. Entries close 12<sup>th</sup> January 2009 with the Secretary, Shifting Sands Arabians, 1810 Merriang Road Beveridge 3753. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE RETURNED UNLESS A STAMPED SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPE IS ENCLOSED.**
5. All exhibits must be wearing a bridle/halter fitted with a throatlatch. No entire may be handled or ridden by an exhibitor under the age of 18 years. Stallions may not be ridden in events 309 & 311.
6. A Novice horse or rider is defined as not having won a first prize in a similar event at any horse show or gymkhana – in any section. All Novice horses must be ridden in a snaffle bit and without spurs. Where a Novice Championship is provided, winners of Novice classes are not eligible for the Open Championship except where also a winner of an open class.
7. A brood mare is defined as having a foal at foot or a current pregnancy certificate and may be shown in only one of brood mare or dry mare class.
8. A judge may award a second or third prize where the exhibits are not considered of sufficient merit. The judge's decision is final.
9. All Perpetual Trophies remain the property of C.A.R.A.B Inc and must be returned to the committee 14 days prior to the Show.
10. Large classes may be divided at the judge's discretion.
11. No protest will be entertained unless it is in writing and is lodged within one hour of the judgement in dispute and accompanied by a \$20.00 fee which will be forfeit should the complaint be thought frivolous.
12. Conduct by exhibitors regarded as unacceptable may result in disqualification from all awards gained and may extend to disbaring from future events.
13. Exhibitors enter entirely at their own risk. In case any exhibit, while on the showgrounds, shall cause or be the cause of injury or damaged to any other exhibit or the general public, the owner of such animal shall indemnify the club, its officials and members from and against all damages, costs and claims, expenses or liabilities incurred.
14. The committee reserve the right to alter, combine, add to or delete any event in the programme or timetable at any time.
15. The committee reserve the right to reject any entry at any time.
16. There will be **NO REFUND** of ENTRY MONIES.
17. Amateur Owner – as per A.H.S.A Ltd. Rule Book Halter /Ridden to be judged 100% on Horse. Must hold an A.H.S.A Ltd Amateur Card. 18. **New A.H.S.A Ltd Rule – Stirring:** Exhibits are not to be excessively stirred-up. Horses must remain calmly in the marshalling area with a maximum of one handler/rider & one groom until they enter the ring at walk or a trot. No devices, artificial gadgets or loud noises shall be used to excite waiting horses. This rule also applies to other person on the outside of the ring or marshalling area. Exhibits who are excessively excited may be asked to leave the ring or marshalling area & will not be judged. Persons failing to obey this rule may have their exhibit disqualified from the class. Handlers are not to excite stallions to challenge by facing them up to each other or crowding them. The facing up of stallions is strictly prohibited. **WHIP ABUSE OF ANY KIND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
19. Whip length for all HALTER classes, any WHIP which may be carried in a Halter class or in the marshalling area will have a maximum length of 110cm.
