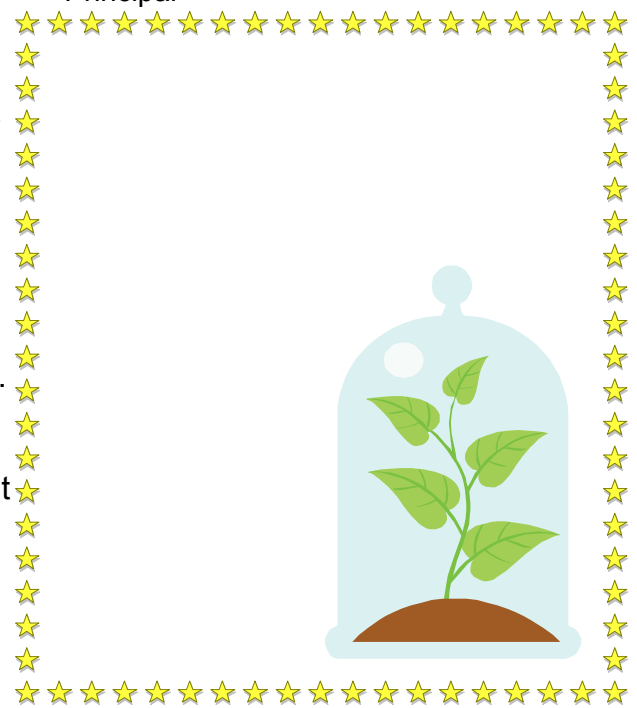
Breakfast Club
