Student Behaviour

Like all schools, at Carlton Primary School we have rules about acceptable behaviour. These rules are about making sure that our school is a safe place where children can learn well and teachers can do their job properly. We talk about our rules often, both in classes and at assemblies. When children choose to break our school rules there are consequences for this. This can range from a warning, to a lunchtime detention, an “in school” suspension or even a formal suspension where children are required to stay away from school for a period of days. The consequence depends on the child’s age and the seriousness of the behaviour. When children are repeatedly breaking school rules, their parents are contacted so that families and the school can work together to help the child to improve their behaviour. Thank you to those parents who always support the school in behaviour management with their child, by doing this you are sending a very strong message about how you expect your children to behave. We know that children who grow up understanding and following society’s rules are the ones who will have the most successful outcomes in their teenage and adult lives.

Further to this, the other staff and I have been very disturbed this week to hear about some of the dangerous and inappropriate behaviour that has been happening on the housing estate on the weekend and evenings. If you are aware of anyone, children or adults, breaking the law with threatening or dangerous behaviour, please contact the police immediately.
