On the following page is a summary of the team draw.
Please read.

How the Team Draw Works

1. Grades are based on a draw with 5 teams.
2. Some grades have a bye/s.
3. Every team competes against each other twice over the 5 sessions.
4. Points are awarded for every relay swum – 5 win and 2 loss. These are the “Event Points”.
5. Once all the relays on the night have been swum the points are added up.
6. Premiership Points – 4 win – 2 draw are then awarded to the winning team.
7. Premiership Points are judged team versus team.
8. On some nights a team might only compete against one other team.
9. Another team might compete against 2 teams.
