- Victorian Index to Wills, Probate and Administration Records 1841-2009
- Queensland indexes to wills 1857-1940
- NSW deceased estates and related records. Use the State Records Archives Investigator to search for Probate Packets by entering a surname and the word 'death'.
- Tasmanian Wills and letters of administration 1824-1989
