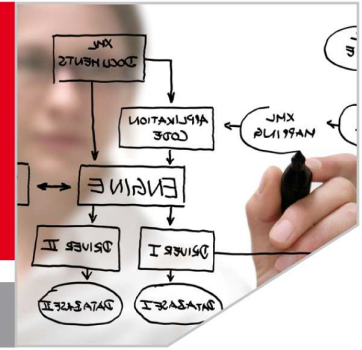

In 1984 he became a Member of the Order of Australia (AM) for services to engineering and education.
