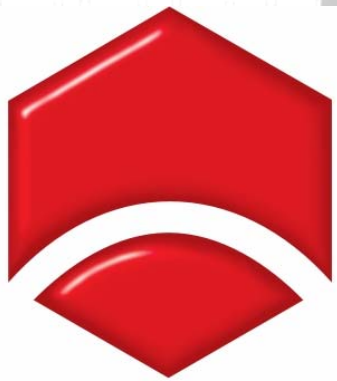

## Call for Papers

Should you wish to contribute an occasional paper, please follow the guidelines below. Papers should address the principal conference themes. The Conference Secretariat must receive abstracts no later than **Friday 30 March 2007**. The only method of abstract submission is by email to [engheritage@debretts.com.au](mailto:engheritage@debretts.com.au) Receipt of your abstract will be acknowledged. Acceptance/rejection decisions will be made as soon as possible after the deadline.

Full papers must be submitted by Friday 31 August 2007 to [engheritage@debretts.com.au](mailto:engheritage@debretts.com.au) If you wish to submit an abstract for consideration, you must also intend to register for the conference. Final acceptance is conditional on registration by Friday 26 October 2007.

Abstracts (maximum of 300 words) should be sent as an **email attachment** in the following format:

- Document name: Use your surname and first initial of your first name e.g. Smith, B.
- Style: use 'normal style' only
- Margins: 2.5 centimetres all around
- Title of paper: Arial font, 14 point, bold
- All other sections of submitted abstract: Arial font, 11 point
- Authors' names: in capitals, surname followed by initials e.g. SMITH B (asterisk presenting author)
- Keywords: Three keywords relating to the abstract
- Audiovisual requirements (An overhead projector will not be available)
