

Tell your Politicians what you want: - Write a two minute "My Will" letter

Our responsibility is to let our members of parliament know what we want them to do. This is done by writing *My Will Letters*.

On a PC, fill in the subject, address details, date and print the letter – or just write out by hand. Deliver by mail or personal delivery (in an envelope with your politician's name on it).

For example:

Your Two Minute Letter:

<Date>

<My Name & Postal Address>

<Politician's Name and Address>

Dear _____,

My will is that you immediately stop the fluoridation of our drinking water supplies.

Yours sincerely,
<signed>
<My name>

Politician's Response:

The politician's office staff will usually send a standard letter quoting false information from the Health Department.

Write again:

Dear _____,

In reply to the "My Will" letter on fluoridation you sent a health department response. You misunderstand. I was not debating. I was simply informing you of my will on the subject.

Yours sincerely,
<signed>
<My name>

Easy isn't it! Ask others to write letters too.

The more people writing two minute letters within a given electorate, the more attentive a politician becomes. The number one thing that motivates any politician is the concern of losing his or her seat. With 1000 letters or even more, it becomes an increasingly hot seat. And rightly so, for anyone approving of toxic and cumulative silicofluorides being added to our community's drinking water!

This letter format can be used with ANY issue - it is democracy in action.
