# Pat Claridge Meeting Room and Library Toilet Facilities

It has come to the notice of FOBL that the Pat Claridge meeting room, previously used as a community meeting room by a number of groups, including FOBL, is now fully occupied on a permanent basis by Council employees.

The toilet facilities are screened off for the sole use of these Council employees. Geraldine contacted Pat Claridge to ascertain her knowledge of these arrangements, Pat was prepared to ask the Mayor, Danny Claridge, to bring this situation to the notice of Councillors and the CEO.

Points noted were:

- Room was intended for community meetings, which were booked through the Council.
- The toilets, were intended for community use, the toilet block under the library is not easily accessible from the library for the elderly, disabled or young children.
- There is a staff toilet in the Library.
- The excellent level of facilities in the disabled toilet at the library are not available anywhere else in Benalla. These are currently closed to the public.

After much discussion a Motion was moved.

**Motion:** A letter be written on behalf of the Friends of the Benalla Library, to the CEO, Mayor and Councillors requesting an explanation of the inavailability of the toilets and meeting rooms and requesting that Council notify us of the expected timeline when they will be made available for community use again.
