Thank you again for accepting our application for funding for the purchase of a Camera / Digital Camera for our Volunteer Group. The camera we have chosen was a **Canon Digital Single Lens Reflex Camera, model EOS 40D**. It was purchased from the Harvey Norman Store in Knox City, a Shopping Centre East of Melbourne, for \$2755.00. A copy of the receipt is attached.

We realise this cost exceeds the original price stated in our funding application, but have decided to go for this particular camera because of its advance features and its versatility, and our members will make up the difference in the purchase price.

The range of Digital Cameras is increasing rapidly and features previously only available on costly professional models are now being introduced to the Home and Office users. The 10 Mega-Pixel element, the instant start, the SLR facility, the extended battery life and the interchangeable, stabilised Macro-Lens all go together to make this a quality instrument and a joy to use. The cost of an extended Warranty Service, a 2GB memory card and an all-weather Carry Bag are included in the purchase price.

As stated previously we, the Friends of Kurth Kiln, have ongoing projects requiring the use of a quality camera, in our Cultural Heritage Artefacts Register, in promoting greater awareness of the historic significance of Kurth Kiln in energy management to the wider public, and in bush environment issues of Kurth Kiln Regional Park. The new digital camera will be a valuable addition to our "tools of trade".

Thank you for sending us the grey "Australian Government Volunteer Support" stickers, supplied as part of the VSEG 2007 grants. The oval stickers are too large to fit on the camera body itself, so we have affixed one to the outside of the "Lowepro" carrying case. It looks good there, and we take pride in promoting the government's recognition of the value volunteer groups like us are contribution to Australia's natural and social environment..
