ABBREVIATED CLUB RULES AND POLICIES

Diving Donations: Members \$35 & Visitors \$40 per diver per day. The Committee have discretion to alter dive donations for closer or further locations. Members must advise visitors of expected donations and rules.

Dive Bookings: Dives should be booked with the nominated dive organiser as early as possible. Bookings are on a first in first served basis. Divers must confirm with the organiser on the night before the dive, just after the broadcasted weather report. On dives where a deposit is required, divers who cancel after payment of the deposit are expected to find a replacement diver otherwise all costs will be due. Most dives are organised on an ad-hoc basis once the weather conditions are known. Check with a committee member or the activities coordinator prior to the weekend for details of dives being organised.

Boat Rules: All members using a boat MUST help with retrieval and cleaning of the boat afterwards. All recreational fishing rules must be observed.

Scuba Tank Filling: Air card of 10 fills \$50, Single fills \$8 Tanks MUST be in test to be filled.

Minimum Equipment: Current club rules expect ALL divers to have an Octopus Regulator, Buoyancy compensator & Safety Sausage on ALL dives.

GetUnder Newsletter: GetUnder is published every two months, February, April, June, August, October, and December. Contributions are required - without them the Newsletter may not happen. Items should be supplied on a disk or emailed, (most word processor formats will be OK). Items can include dive reports, your equipment adverts, or any item gleaned from magazines and the like, however, articles written by Club members generally take precedence. Contributions should be sent to the Newsletter Editor as soon as you write them. **Please send photos as JPG files. I can't use them if they're embedded in Word.**
