### AIM

These classes are provided to expand on the study that you completed in 2009.  
To provide the student the opportunity to study the characteristics, preparation and spinning techniques, of a variety of protein and cellulose fibres, so as to understand the spinning process, in order to design and produce yarns for a specific purpose. To be able to further pursue any area of interest in which the student wishes to further develop knowledge and expertise.

### OBJECTIVES

To understand the properties of different fibres.  
To develop expertise in a variety of different spinning techniques.  
To be able to spin to a given specification for a special purpose.  
To explore the properties of yarn design.  
To produce a comprehensive reference folio (optional for your information)  
To explore the dyeing process.

Students to provide fibres for the course, except where special arrangements are made. i.e. in some instances bulk or luxury fibres will be sourced by the teaching committee and provided to students for a small additional fee.

Instruction will be given in all topics during the course.

Students will be provided with access details to convenor and all tutors so that any queries can be answered quickly.

Saturday February 13<sup>th</sup> – Spinning cotton. Learn how to handle the short fibres of cotton.

Saturday March 13<sup>th</sup> – Spinning flax, rami and hemp. Work with the baste fibres.

Saturday April 10<sup>th</sup> – Colour theory and how to create a theme. Create a colour wheel and learn how to create a theme to work from.

Saturday May 8<sup>th</sup> – Dying. Dying your protien fibres.

Saturday June 12<sup>th</sup> – Dying. Dying your cellouse fibres.

Saturday July 10<sup>th</sup> – Natural dying. Can we say more.

Saturday August 14<sup>th</sup> – A weekend of textured yarns. Learn plying techniques, how to core spin, etc.

Saturday September 11<sup>th</sup> - Indigo Dying.

Saturday October 9<sup>th</sup> – Yarn analysis and fibre sandwich. Learn how to duplicate yarns by digesting them and participating in a fibre sandwich.
