

STAGE 3A WATER RESTRICTIONS.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION.

Earlier this year courts 5 and 6 at Karingal Drive were given a treatment to enhance water retention. This treatment will be repeated later this year.

As a result of the treatment, under stage 3A water restrictions we applied and were successful in gaining approval for a New Water Conservation Plan. We have also established a long term surface development plan.

These actions enable us to use these courts for both social and competition play.

The cost of the treatment was funded equally by Banyule City Council, Tennis Victoria and the Victorian State Government, and we are grateful to each of those parties for their ongoing financial support with this initiative.

In accordance with arrangements under the new water conservation plan Yarra Valley Water has set a target for the amount of water we are permitted to use. Accordingly we have to take regular readings and report our usage. If we exceed our allocation we may be forced to cut back which may mean reducing the number of courts that are available for play.

Members please note the procedure to be followed for watering courts.
Ie 1. BOTH COURTS MAY BE USED.

**2. LIGHT HAND HELD HOSE WATERING IS
ALLOWED AT THE START OF EACH SET FOR THOSE
COURTS IN USE.**

**3. COURTS MUST NOT BE WATERED AT THE
COMPLETION OF PLAY BUT ARE TO BE BAGGED.**

4. NO SPRINKLER SYSTEMS ARE IN USE.

We ask that members co operate with us and follow the above instructions, keeping water usage to a minimum.
