



Annual Children's Competition

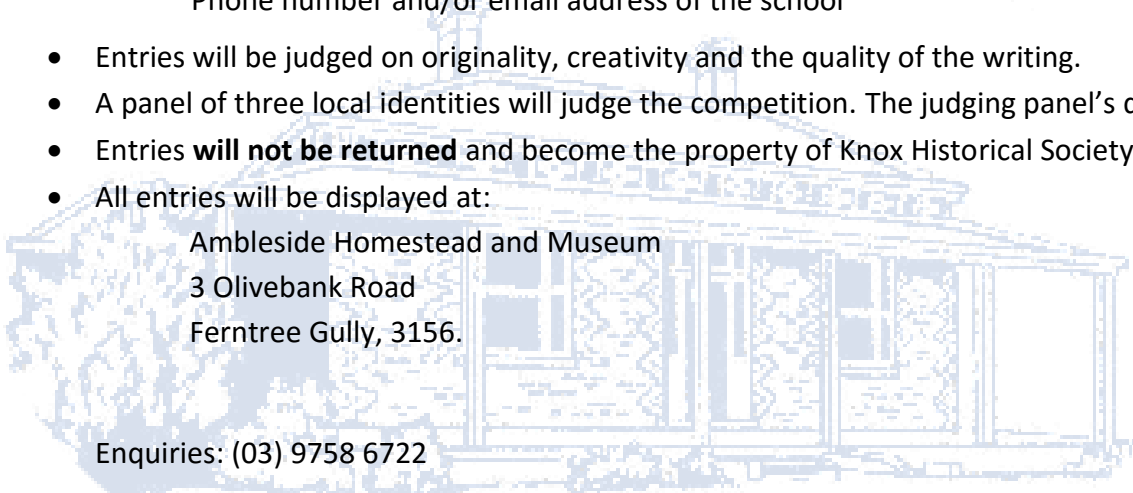
