Cover: This seal was copied from a book on our library shelves (FHS 415 LEW) called A Topographical Dictionary of Ireland. by Samuel Lewis. The book, in two volumes, was originally published in 1837 and contains historical and statistical descriptions of the counties, cities, boroughs, corporate, market and post towns. parishes and villages of Ireland. I find the physical descriptions of some places very interesting. The houses (how many, their size and condition and what they are built of), streets, bridges, castles, rivers and surrounding countryside are sometimes described in great detail. Schools, churches, and industry are also mentioned. With a little imagination I can picture my ancestors leaving their irregularly built house, walking passed the barracks, over the bridge with two arches and passed the flour mill to the fair on Nov. 21st. 1837.

Recent editions of the Wangaratta, Echuca/Moama and Geelong newsletters have lists of unrelated certificates.


Many groups are now on the net and their homepage addresses can be found in their newsletters.
