



MUSIC LOVERS' SOCIETY

The Music Lovers' Society was founded in 1952 by a group led by the late Mr Joseph James, Mr Theodore Sartory, Mr Hayward Owen and the first Honorary Secretary, Mr Harold Newey, to help young musicians in musical knowledge and appreciation, and especially in the development of performance skills.

The aims of the Society are therefore

The cultivation of the enjoyment of music by concerts, encouragement and assistance to young students to give musical concerts.

The provision of scholarships or funds for selected students to pursue their musical studies both here and overseas.

We appeal to fellow music lovers to support us so that we can continue to assist talented young artists to further their careers.

Membership covers eight concerts, including one or two Ida Doubleday Bequest Concerts, and one concert presented with the Annual General Meeting. Special concerts are also held; members are admitted to these at the concession rate. For disabled patrons requiring a carer, one ticket admits the patron and carer.

THE IDA DOUBLEDAY BEQUEST

Ida Doubleday, who died on 22 December 1976, practised as a Singing Teacher in Melbourne for many years and no doubt will be remembered by many of her pupils. The Ida Doubleday Bequest represents a Trust dated 1 March 1980, in respect of \$22,415 left to the Music Lovers' Society as Administrators

“For the specific purpose of sponsoring recitals by young musicians and vocalists conditional that the vocalists sing in English.”

The performance grant is currently set at \$250 per artist, and \$125 for the accompanist.
