***Monday 3rd*** Meet at Mansfield pub for lunch, camp Pikes Flat

***Tuesday 4th*** Bindaree Falls, Lunch at Craig’s Hut (Mt Buller close by) Circuit Rd, Little Speculation Rd, Cobbler Track. Camp at Lake Cobbler (alt route being considered to Cobblers via Staircase, Cobbler Lake Track)

***Wednesday 5th*** Abbeyard Lake Cobbler Track, Dandongadale Buffalo Divide Rd to Dandongadale. Lunch Goldie Spur Rd, Buckland Valley Rd to Porepunka **Fuel, food** and camp

***Thursday 6th*** Buckland Valley Rd, Mt Selwyn Rd, Buffalo Rd, East Riley Rd, Wonnangatta Track to Wonnangatta River and eventual campsite somewhere along the Wonnangatta River

***Friday 7th*** Free day to just enjoy the beautiful Wonnangatta Valley. Plenty of 4 x 4 side trips available, fishing, reading a book or simply doing nothing

***Saturday 8th*** Wonnangatta to Dargo via the Crooked River – plenty of river crossings. Camp near Dargo **Fuel, food** and a great pub at Dargo

***Sunday 9th*** Junction Spur Trails Track to the Pinnacles ( excellent views from lookout tower - a short steep walk) then descend via Billy Goat Bluff Track back to base camp at Dargo

***Monday 10th*** Blue Rag Track

***Tuesday 11th*** Dargo to Omeo via Cassilis winery Camp north of Omeo

***Wednesday 12th*** Trip to Dartmouth Dam

***Thursday 13th*** Bogong High Plains trip
