“Our Shrinking Workforce”

Australia, like the rest of the world, is starting to feel the effects of our ageing workforce. The supply of younger workers entering the workforce is drying up. Today there are about 170,000 new entrants to the workforce each year. But in the whole decade 2020-2030, Access Economics predicts there will only be a total of 180,000 new entrants. Consequently, employers are facing a worker crisis with more people expected to leave the workforce than join it over the next decade. Employers who can encourage their older experienced and competent workers to stay with them longer or who can recruit new mature aged employees will be better placed to cope with the dramatic changes in labour supply.
