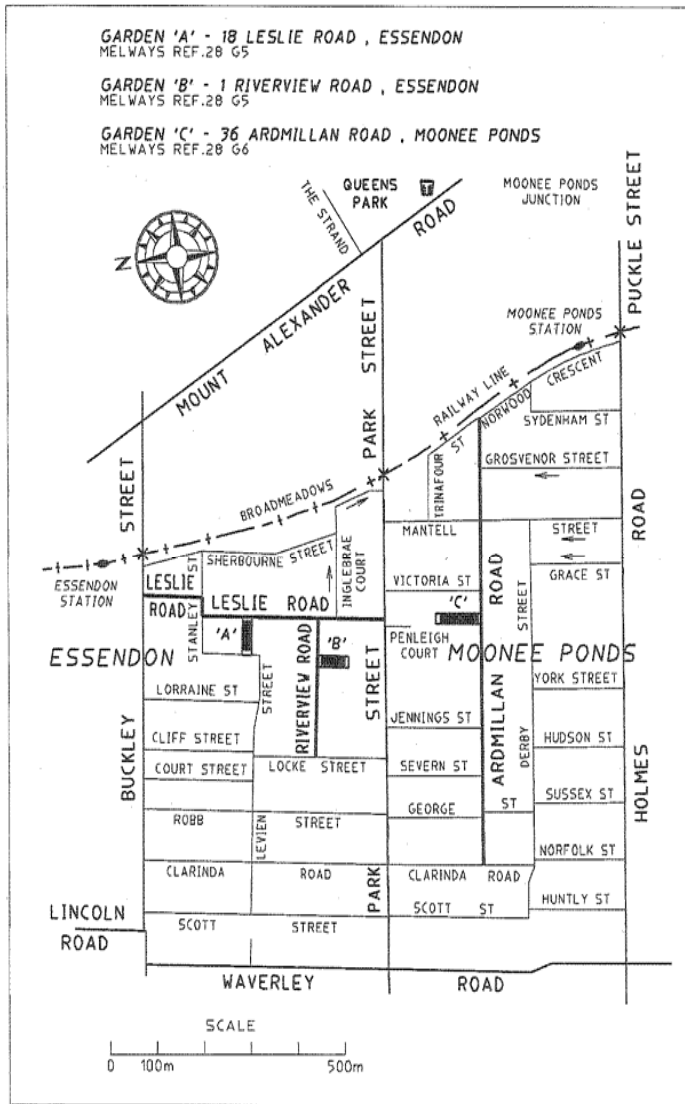

18 Leslie Road, Essendon

Circular front lawn with magnificent Crepe Myrtle in centre. Borders of box hedge, in front of iceberg roses, azaleas and camellias.

The rear garden has been re-paved approximately 50 cubic metres of compost, soil and mulch. Replanting started only 6 months ago. Features include callery pears, sasanqua's, spanish laurel, rose varieties, box hedge, lots of ground cover.

The pergola with ornamental grape vine and boston ivy, leaves will turn crimson in its very first autumn. This rear garden has been planted with trees, shrubs and ground cover because of their water friendly requirements.



1 Riverview Road, Essendon

The large front garden has a strong formal theme, featuring ornamental pears, layered hedging, using small leaf lilly pilly, sasanqua camelias, david austin roses, azaleas and box hedging. There is a central rose partierre garden and a 6 x 2 metre reflective pond.

The recently completed back garden flows from the front with fragrant viburnum hedging which follows the garden perimeter verandah. The garden is divided into two with a feature stack stone wall dividing the courtyard to a lower tiered garden, featuring autumn blaze maple trees, small leaf lilly pilly, sasanqua camelias with a layered hedging affect. The lower tier is drawn by an antique jar water feature.



36 Ardmillan Road, Moonee Ponds

An English style garden set on a half acre block, with hedges, sweeping lawns, paths and elegant trees which compliment the Victorian residence circa 1887.

Plants include azaleas, camellias, rhodendums, roses with a kitchen garden on the back boundary, this includes herbs, citrus, olive and some fruit trees.
