### 1. MAKE SURE TO SEND BACK YOUR REGISTRATION FORM!

### 2. CANCELLATIONS

### 3. PARKING

To make sure we don't do more damage than good, parking will be provided at Phillip Island Nature Park (refer to map on back). Be there by 9.00am. Free shuttle buses will take you to Ventnor Common for the day and return you to your car by 4.30pm – 5.00pm.

### 4. WALKING OR CYCLING TO VENTNOR COMMON

Be on site by 9.30am and head straight to the volunteer registration tent first. Enter via Ventnor Beach Road.

### 5. WHAT TO BRING

- Sturdy footwear
- Hat
- Gardening Gloves
- Waterproof jacket
- Sunscreen
- Water bottle, cup for hot drinks and snacks!
- A hand trowel or Hamilton Tree Planter (if you have one)

- 10.00am - Go to the 'Main Tent' for start of activities
- Follow your team leaders
- Work hard and smile for the cameras
- Finish around 4.00 – 4.30pm
- Buses will depart between 4:30 – 5:00 pm
