**Chairman & President Leo** made a presentation to DG wife, Margaret of a cheque of \$100 towards a gazebo to be constructed at Rotary's Centenary House Margaret explained that the Gazebo would house a BBQ and seating and be an informal gathering space for visitors and residents she also requested that she is collecting stamps (on envelopes) and would appreciate the support of members in this regard.

**Leo** Then introduced DG Ken a member of the Dandenong club since 1985 and a retired Police officer, having spent some time in Bairnsdale in the sixties. Ken said that he had memories of Sale, particularly when he was playing football for Bairnsdale. He described his attendance at the Detroit training session for DG's, all 530 worldwide where Rotary International President D K Lee presented the statistic that every day 30,000 children under the age of 5 die from drinking contaminated water and that the emphasis of his year in office would to improve water supply and sanitation and improve literacy so that communities have a better understanding of issues such as starvation.

He then exhorted us to attend the district conference in Albury on the 20<sup>th</sup> -22<sup>nd</sup> March

In conclusion Leo thanked him for his attendance and offered the Clubs best wishes for a successful term as District Governor
