**LAGOON BIRDS**

Two significant raptors nest regularly in the taller Eucalypts on the bank opposite. The Whistling Kite (*Haliastur sphenurus*) pictured and the less common and very impressive White bellied Sea Eagle (*Haliaeetus leucogaster*).

The surrounding trees and reeds provide a home for many smaller passerine species the most common of which include the Brown Thornbill (*Acanthiza pusilla*) and Striated Thornbill (*Acanthiza lineata*) and from spring to late summer the Reed Warbler (*Aerospiza australis*) and the White-browed Scrubwren (*Sericornis frontalis*).

Higher in the trees many different varieties of honeyeater can be observed throughout the year along with both the Spotted Pardalote (*Pardalotus punctatus*) and Striated Pardalote (*Pardalotus striatus*) which seek terps in the foliage of the larger eucalypts.
