Monday 24 August 2009 Meeting Report Chairman for the night Neil welcomed the 18 Rotarians present and the guest speaker Dr Anske Robinson who is a Research Fellow with the Monash



University Department of Rural and Indigenous Health, located at Moe. Dr Robinson explained the extent of medical student teaching of the overall School of Rural Health which the

Department is part of, and informed the Rotary Club members of the research and education conducted by the Department. She explained that the Department is part of the School of Rural health, which has Regional Clinical Schools at Mildura, Bendigo, Traralgon and Bairnsdale. Dr Robinson highlighted that the Department has a diverse range of researchers that includes psychologists, pharmacists, nurses, family counselors, and sociologists. Key research areas of the Department identified were Indigenous health, mental health and interprofessional collaborative Practice, support needs for people with cancer, the wellness and wellbeing of rural people, and



rural access to health care. She also informed the members of the post-graduate education undertaken by the Department, and described how it allowed

health care professionals to expand their knowledge of rural health care within the context of their own disciplines. She added that the Department provided both a coursework postgraduate education course, as well as the research based Master and PhD options. Dr Robinson finalised her talk by speaking about her own research on issues of accessing health care in rural communities.
