Monday 31 August 2009 Meeting Report Chairman for the night Don welcomed the 22 Rotarians, partners Bette, Christine, Gillian, Jill and Lois, our youth exchange student Ina and guest speaker Frank Fisher and his wife Gwen. During



the afternoon Frank, who is the District's representative for Australia Rotary Health Fund, presented Mavis (PHF) and Bill (PP) Jennings with the Ruby Companion award, the first in the district recognizing their contribution of \$20,000 to the Fund. Frank commented that the fund was established in 1981 as the dream of late Ian Scott a member of the Mornington Club. The fund is now the largest independent health research fund in the country. \$22m has been spent on research and scholarships over the period. Last year \$2.5m was allocated to re-

search 25 Rural Health Scholarships of \$5,000 per annum and 68 rural nursing scholarships were funded.

Frank presented our club with a flag to note that the Club had contributed and average of \$270 per member in 2008 In answer to a question Frank advised that if a club donated \$2,500 towards a scholarship the fund would contribute \$2,500 and the Club could then determine the location of the student.
