Monday Report Monday 14th September

Chairman David T welcomed the seventeen Rotarians present and guest speaker Dr Vaughan Reimers lecturer in business studies Monash University Gippsland whose topic was Your "Town Your Say" A sample of residents of Morwell, Sale and Traralgon completed questionnaire with respect to their views, preference and attitudes



towards shopping and the shopping facilities within their community The following table are the responses to the question as to **which retail centre do you prefer to shop in – the downtown area or the shopping mall?**

Town	Downtown	Mall	I like them equally
Morwell	27%	38%	35%
Traralgon	22%	23%	55%
Sale	25%	25%	50%

The close proximity between the mall and downtown area in Traralgon and Sale means their residents are more likely to shop at both. In either case, the news for Gippsland is good. Rather than compete against each other, malls and downtown strips appear to serve different needs: grocery shopping is often undertaken in the downtown area, and 'fun' shopping in the mall.
