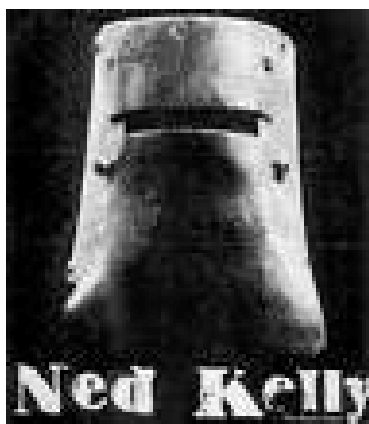


March 2007, motorcycle tour to Beechworth & places made famous by the Kelly Gang



8:00am Saturday 10th March, meet at **Todd Road Shell Service Station**, depart 8:20am sharp.
A short stop at **Beveridge** to visit old Kelly home and Roman Catholic Church/School. (toilet/fuel)
Ride to Old Coach House in **Avenel** for morning tea and visit Cemetery where Ned's father is buried.
Ride to **Benalla** to visit grave-site of Joseph Byrne, then lunch at Royal Hotel.
Then visit Boot Shop, Court House, plus Costume & Pioneer Museum at Benalla.
Afternoon tea at **Glenrowan** and visit Kates Cottage and Seige Site. (250km refuel on highway)
Overnight at Carriage Motor Inn in **Beechworth**. You must book your own accommodation for Sat & Sun nights.
7:00pm dinner at Hibernian Hotel followed by a Kelly Quiz. (Prize for winner)

8:00am Sunday 11th March, breakfast at Beechworth Bakery.
9am Guided walking tour of Beechworth Historic Precinct for an hour, rest of morning free.
2:00pm Sunday afternoon, optional scenic ride through nearby mountains with afternoon tea stop at Bright.
7:00pm dinner at venue of popular choice.

8:00am Monday 12th March, breakfast at Beechworth Bakery, or where ever.
9am departure, morning tea at **Whitfield**, (toilet/fuel) then onto **Powers Lookout** & views of King Valley.
Ride onto **Stringybark Creek**, where 3 Police were shot. (12km good gravel road)
Lunch at **Mansfield** and visit Police Memorial and Cemetery to see 3 Police Graves. (215km refuel)
Arrive 4:30pm at **Yarra Glen** for afternoon tea at Family Pizza Restaurant. Cuddles & Kisses.
