



# Mandate to Parliament

To the Premier of Victoria, the Honorable The President and members of the Legislative Council, the Honorable The President and members of the Legislative Assembly that are assembled under oath in Parliament, and who are humble before God and the righteous citizens of Victoria and who are duty bound to act upon mandates of the electors of Victoria.

It is my duty as an elector of the State of Victoria to present to you this mandate that you may know in full knowledge my will with respect to the Toll charges of *Transurban CityLink Limited* (ACN 070 810 678) and the *A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999*, hereinafter referred to as the GST Act; such mandate being:-

1. **Remove the CityLink Tolls.** No road tolls shall ever again exist on any Victorian roads. Herein are 8 of over 30 reasons why the tolls are ILLEGAL and must be removed. (See UPMART and their petition to the Legislative Council of Victoria version 1.1b 30/03/2000 for more reasons)
  - 1.1 **Tolls discriminate against all Victorians.** Drivers from other States and Territories are exempt per Section 92 of our constitution which states "*customs, trade, commerce and intercourse among the States.....shall be absolutely free*"
  - 1.2 **Tolls discriminate** against the poor and unfairly target certain communities along the CityLink routes.
  - 1.3 It is our legal **Right of Passage** under common law to use Victorian roads without charge or cost.
  - 1.4 CityLink tolls require payment for roads that have **already been fully paid for** by the taxpayer.
  - 1.5 The Victorian Government **did not have a mandate** to create the CityLink Legislation.
  - 1.6 The closure and alteration of roads to deliberately funnel traffic to CityLink is **unfair, anti-competitive and unlawful.**
  - 1.7 The Victorian Government blatantly misled the people **about the entire money question** and funding options. The Government did not use the proper and abundant means of funding available to it under section 51-13 of the Australian Constitution, which was clearly the best, the cheapest and least complex choice and one which would not incur any debt or burden whatsoever to Victorians. Neither did it use already existing and abundant funds from petrol taxes etc.
2. **Withdraw from the GST Act arrangements with the Federal Government.**
3. **Inform and instruct on my behalf** both the Governor General (under **section 59** of the Australian Constitution) and the Commonwealth Parliament to repeal (**remove**) **the GST Act**. It is a fact that the Government received less than 40% of the primary Vote and did not have a Mandate for the GST Act. Further **section 165-55** of the GST Act gives the Taxation Commissioner **power to make decisions irrespective of the truth.**

It says the commissioner may

- "(a) treat a particular event that actually happened as not having happened; and
- (b) treat a particular event that did not actually happen as having happened and, if appropriate, treat the event as:
  - (i) having happened at a particular time; and
  - (ii) having involved particular action by a particular entity; and
- (c) treat a particular event that actually happened as:
  - (i) having happened at a time different from the time it actually happened; or
  - (ii) having involved particular action by a particular entity (whether or not the event actually involved any action by that entity)."

Upon the presentation to the Parliament of Victoria of this mandate that has been duly endorsed by more than 50% of voters in my electorate, which are entitled to vote at the election of a member of the Legislative Assembly and also of the Legislative Council you are hereby notified that immediately thereafter and forever more the citizens of my electorate are legally exempt under Article 20 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights 1948, Magna Carter, Bill of rights and other laws not herein mentioned from the CityLink Tolls and the GST Act. Further that upon the presentation to the Parliament of Victoria of this mandate that has been duly endorsed by more than 50% of registered voters in the State of Victoria which voters are entitled to vote at the election of a member of the Legislative Assembly and also of the Legislative Council you are hereby notified that immediately thereafter all Victorians are legally exempt on grounds formentioned from the GST Act and the CityLink Tolls.
