- Set up & pack up times strictly limited to:

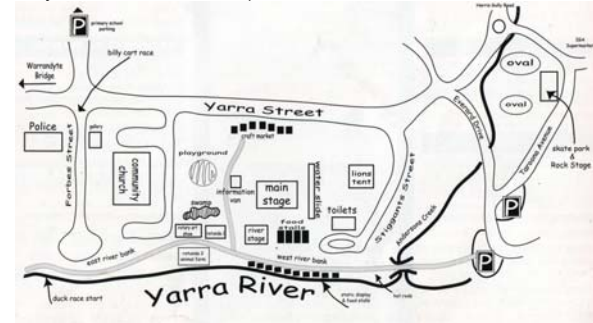
	<i>Set up</i>	<i>Pack Up</i>
Sat 21 st March:	8 am to 9 am	4 pm – 4.30 pm
Sun 22 nd March:	8 am to 9 am.	4.30 pm – 5 pm
- Vehicles will not be permitted within the market area between 9am and 4pm, Saturday or 9.30am and 4.30pm Sunday.
- No power is available to sites.
- Each site measures approximately 3x3 metres.
- The stallholder must supply own tables, tents, shelters etc.
- No security is provided for stall holders who leave stalls/tents up overnight.
- Entrances to a parking area adjacent to the market area by permit only.
- Stallholders are covered for Public Liability provided by the Warrandyte Community Market.
- Stallholders must possess their own Public Liability Insurance.
- Stallholders selling food products must comply with Manningham City Council's Health Department requirements.
- Due to the nature of Warrandyte, please note that no site will be perfectly level. Please allow for this.
- No shows on the day will not be re-invited the following year.
