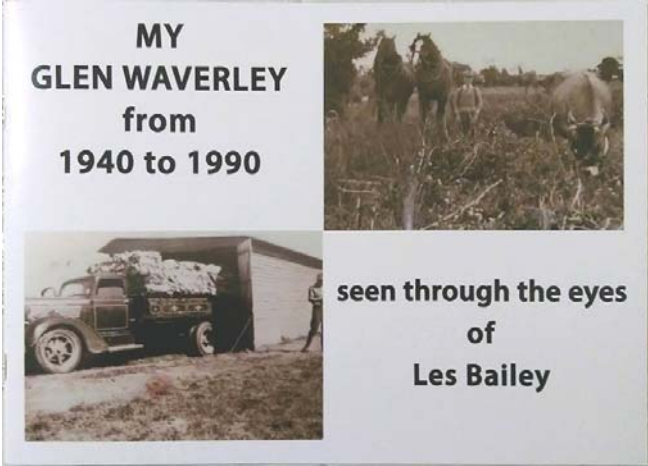


MY GLEN WAVERLEY
