Page 7 - Mr. Wheeler was James, not John

Page 32, 3rd photo. - Fran and Kate Chivers (names have been swapped).

Page 52 - The shop is not an old Nissen hut, but a Robin Boyd design, possibly reminiscent of the Nissen huts of the Migrant Hostel on Warrigal Rd and those at Ashburton Station.

Page 58 - The Lone Pine shown grows at the original War memorial in Central Reserve, not at the RSL.

Page 63 - Miller Crescent, not Court

Page 70 - The "Original Children" sculpture is in the grounds of Ashwood Secondary College, not Ashwood Primary School.

Page 80 - Not Templars but Templer Church - see books in WHS collection
