YABBA invites all students to nominate up to four titles onto the 2012 YABBA shortlist.

The books your students nominate as their favourites will be collated with those from other participating schools and libraries, across Australia. The 10 most popular books in each section will be on the 2012 Shortlist.

You are encouraged to collect the maximum number of nominations possible, in all of the four YABBA sections. Don't worry if you are unsure if a title fits into a particular section, simply record the information in the most appropriate section.

The Shortlist, Poster will be distributed in second term 2012.

1. REAL Awards

Reading & Enjoying Australian Literature Awards

Any student from Prep to Year 9 may participate in the nominations.

2. Any student may choose to nominate up to four titles.

Nominations might include three novels and one picture storybook or maybe four favourite picture storybooks.

3. Books eligible for nomination:

* Australian children's fiction

* First published after 2002, (i.e. books with a First Published date of 2003 through to 2012.)

* No Previous YABBA winner may be nominated.

4. Books nominated must be the **child's** free choice.
